NYC. His students' plays have been published by Baker's Plays and The Theatre Communications Group.

Leavengood's own published works include Florida Bound, a collection of his plays, Hellenback High, Puss in Boots and the children's book, Cat Moon Do. Leavengood has received grants from Florida Division of Cultural Affairs; Florida Council for the Arts, Pinellas County Arts Council, and the Berrilla Kerr Foundation. Other awards and honors include the Edith Oliver Fellows Award and "Best of the Bay" Playwright in 1997, 1999, 2000 and 2005. He served as Artistic Director of the LiveArts Peninsula Foundation from 2000-2005 and was a proud member of the faculty at Shorecrest Preparatory School for over 25 years.
